Graphic designer, Korrine Kraus has integrated the historical aspects of rail and river during the height of trade for the Railway Goods Shed. The stylish design is vibrant yet classical, echoing a bygone time in a progressive format. So it's full steam ahead for labels, six packs and cartons!
