Brewery arrives...

In mid October 2005, the brewery purchased from Beechworth Victoria was dismantled and transported to Goolwa. It is a 22 hectolitre brewery and included a glycol chilling unit and mill.

The equipment is now stored within the shed and awaits the completion of the brew house area.

The bottling line and labeller are in the process of being shipped to Australia along with new conical unitanks for fermenting.



Shed Renovation Complete....

The external restoration of the Railway Goods Shed is now at an end! The final coats of paint and finishing touches have truly transformed the derelict shed into an inviting space to be in.

Brew house construction underway...

Work has now begun on the shed interior. This began with our favourite job – cleaning! Removing the dirt and dust that had accumulated over the 125 years using a steam-pressure cleaner and scaffolding proved to be very muddy but effective. With this messy job done, other aspects could be dealt with. Electrical wiring and replica railway style lights were installed, new floor for the office area laid and a platform for the brew house and bar fabricated on site. It is exciting to see the brewery finally beginning to take shape!
